Our host for the February 14 meeting will be MAGI, Inc. MAGI, headquartered in Elmsford, New York, was founded in 1966 by Dr. Phillip S. Mittelman, a Harvard-and-R.P.I.-trained nuclear physicist.

MAGI has four divisions: CAD/CAM, direct mail, animation and computerized business graphics. The computerized business graphics division, which has a regional office in Santa Monica, markets MAGI's slide-making system, the Major Leaguer. This desk-top system looks like a TV set, works like a typewriter and creates business-related 35mm color slides faster than manual methods and cheaper than vended methods.

Major Leaguer users design their slides on an economical system in their offices, transmit to any of three national production labs to high-quality film recording equipment, and receive their slides back within a designated time period.
